

Removing a Threat from the Allow List

When you remove a threat from the Allow List, Barracuda XDR creates alerts for that threat again.

If you want to re-add the threat later, follow the *To add a threat to the Allow List* procedure on the <u>Adding a Threat to the Allow List</u> page.

You can filter the Allow List page to help you find the threats you're looking for. For more information, see <u>Filtering the Allow List Page</u>.

To remove a threat from the Allow List

- 1. In **Barracuda XDR Dashboard**, click **Administration > Allow List**.
- 2. In the table, click the row of the threat you want to remove from an **Allow List**.
- 3. In the top right corner, click **Remove from Allow List**.
