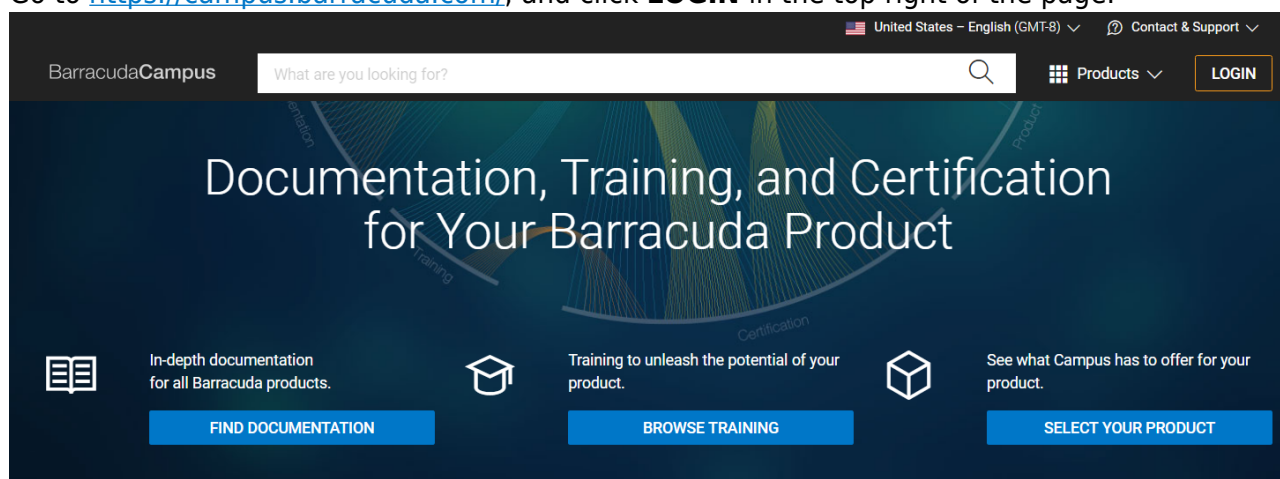
Do I need to log in to view articles?


access additional learning materials and documentation resources, access the full set of courses, and track your training and certification progress.

How do I navigate My Dashboard?

When you log into Barracuda Campus, your Dashboard displays upcoming class registrations, available exams, and your recent activities.

- **My Next Class** – Displays your upcoming class registrations. Click **Show All** to view upcoming and past registrations.
- **Notifications** – Displays current notifications; click the arrow (➤) icon to view the full notification. Click **Show All** to view older notifications.
- **Certificates** – Displays your completed, planned, and expired certificates. Click **Show All** to view completed and expired certificates, as well as recommended certificates.

Additionally, the lower portion of your Dashboard displays your upcoming class registrations, exams,

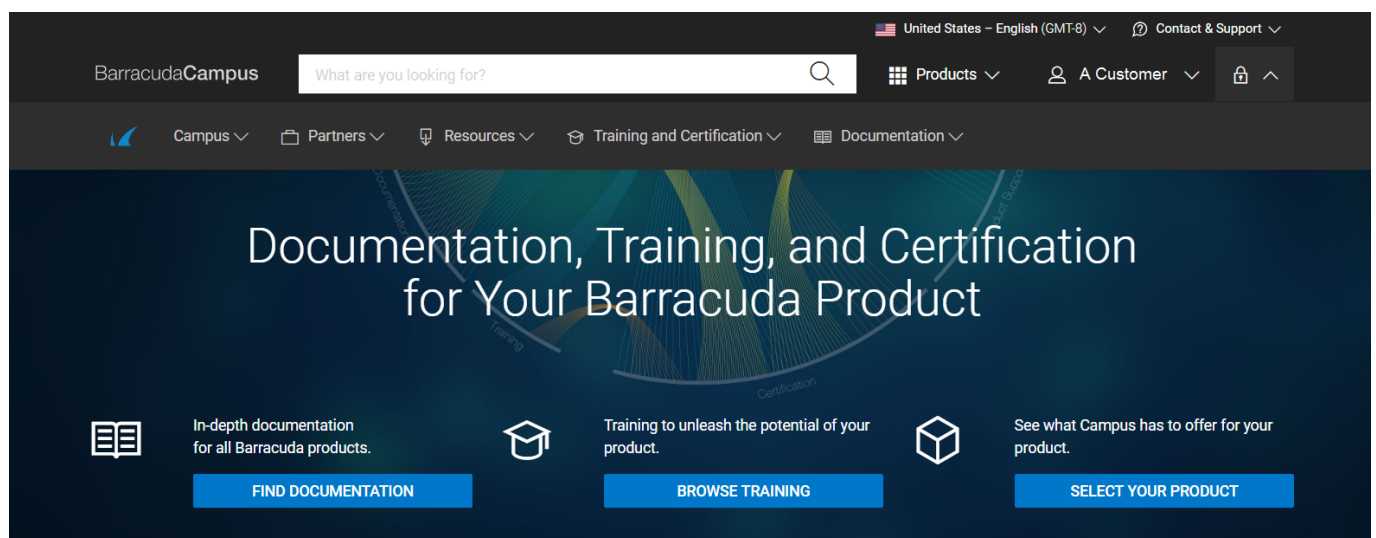
recent activity, and recommendations.

How do I find the Dashboard for my company?

Log into Barracuda Campus. From your personal Dashboard, click one of the arrow (↔) icons to view your company's Dashboard. Click the same arrow (↔) icon again, or the other arrow icon, to return to your Dashboard.

How do I navigate from the Home Page?

The Campus Home Page, <https://campus.barracuda.com/>, provides three main points of entry.




Click one of the blue buttons to get started:

- **Find Documentation** – Directs you to the most viewed and most recently updated Barracuda documentation, as well as to links to product documentation.
- **Browse Training** – Directs you to upcoming seminars, distance learning classes, and webinars.
- **Select Your Product** – Directs you to a list of Barracuda Networks product documentation, sorted by product category. You can also use the search field to find the specific topic you need.

What do the tabs in the product space represent?





Each product space includes the following tabs:

- **Overview** – Click to view a brief description of the product, along with links to recently-updated documentation, training, and product links.
- **Documentation** – Click to view technical documentation for the selected product.
- **Training** – Click to view a subset of available courses; log in to Barracuda Campus to see all available courses.
- **Certificates** – Click to view a subset of available certificates; log in to Barracuda Campus to see all available certificates and certification opportunities.
- **Materials** – Click to view a list of materials related to this product, including videos, data sheets, course guides, and more.



Click **Products**, click a product category, like Security or Data Protection, then click on the desired product.


This works from anywhere within Barracuda Campus. If you are in one product space and want to switch to another one, follow this same process.



This article outlines implementation considerations when deploying the Barracuda Load Balancer ADC in an environment subject to PCI Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) compliance. This article focuses on the requirements placed on the Barracuda Load Balancer ADC for achieving PCI compliance, in an environment that includes the following:

- Barracuda Load Balancer ADC
- Application Server
- Database Server


For [PCI DSS Requirement 6.6 compliance](#) ^[1] and added application security, consider purchasing an Application Security license for the Barracuda Load Balancer ADC.

Efficient PCI Compliance

PCI Compliance applies to entities that process, store, or transmit cardholder data. The Barracuda Load Balancer ADC intelligently distributes traffic among servers for efficient use of server resources, and provides server fail-over for High Availability. The Barracuda Load Balancer ADC, as an underlying technology infrastructure in your network, does not directly manage or store cardholder data. However, it provides a secure environment for the transmission of all application data including cardholder data. For merchants subject to PCI DSS, this facilitates certification attainment.

According to section 4.1 of the [Payment Card Industry \(PCI\) Data Security Standard v1.2](#) ^[2], merchants handling credit card data are required to "...use strong cryptography and security protocols such as SSL/TLS or IPSEC to safeguard sensitive cardholder data during transmission over open, public networks."

Deploying services behind the Barracuda Load Balancer ADC simplifies your PCI compliance by relying on a secure, up-to-date PCI-compliant stack front-end for back-end servers. Additionally, the Barracuda Load Balancer ADC provides risk mitigation and business continuity by relieving your certification process from full scanning, and operating system, middle-ware, and application update and patching on all your Internet-facing production servers which can result in downtime and administrator overhead.

 An information supplement to the PCI DSS notes that as long as the servers behind a load Balancer ADC are configured similarly, they are exempt from an internal scan. For more information, refer to [Account for Load Balancer ADCs](#) ^[3] (page 14 of the [PCI Approved Scanning Vendors Program Guide](#) ^[4]).


How do I search Barracuda Campus?


