

Implementing Global Server Load Balancing Regions

To specify that Global Server Load Balancing (GSLB) regions be used to direct traffic to data centers with region-specific content, navigate to the **TRAFFIC** > **GSLB Services** page and set the **Response Policy** to **Region Only**. When you add a region to a host on the **TRAFFIC** > **GSLB Services** page, traffic that originates in that region is directed to the Site IP address.

Several predefined regions are listed on the **TRAFFIC** > **GSLB Settings** page. You can also create a custom region on that same page. Scroll down to **GSLB Regions** and click **Add Custom Region**. Name the custom region and select one or more small regions from the list. Then click **Save**. Return to the **TRAFFIC** > **GSLB Services** page to specify using the new Custom Region.
