

## Uninstalling the Barracuda Web Security Agent for Win2K8 Server

1. Log on to the server computer as an administrator.
2. Click **Start**, point to **Administrative Tools**, and then click **Group Policy Management**.  
Expand the tree for your domain, select the newly created Container or OU, expand the Container, select the new GPO, right-click and click **Edit...**
3. Expand the Configuration based on the assignment of a new GPO as follows:
  1. Computer Configuration | Policies | Software Settings | Software installation.  
User Configuration | Policies | Software Settings | Software installation.
  2. Select **Software installation** and then select the Software **Barracuda Web Security Agent** from the right side list. Right-click and select **All Tasks > Remove...** This prompts the **Removal** method option. Choose the option **Immediately uninstall the software from users and computers** and click **OK**.
4. Close all the open windows. Run the command to force update of group policy.  
`C:\.Users\Administrator>gpupdate /Force`  
Updating Policy...  
User Policy update has completed successfully.  
Computer Policy update has completed successfully.
  1. Start the same computer on which Barracuda WSA application is installed (computer-based policy).
  2. Log in as the domain user to a machine on which Barracuda WSA application is installed (user-based policy).
  3. Look at the system tray - the Barracuda WSA Monitor icon should not be present. This indicates that Barracuda WSA application has been uninstalled. You can also verify this in the Add/Remove Programs section of the Control Panel.
