Image spam represents about one third of all traffic on the Internet. The Barracuda Email Security Service uses Image Analysis, which includes investigating image dimensions in JPG/JPEG images, to protect against new image variants. In the **Message Log**, Image Analysis may sometimes result in one of the following:

- A message is deferred if determined to be suspicious, with a reason of **Suspicious**
- A message is blocked with a reason of **Image Analysis**
