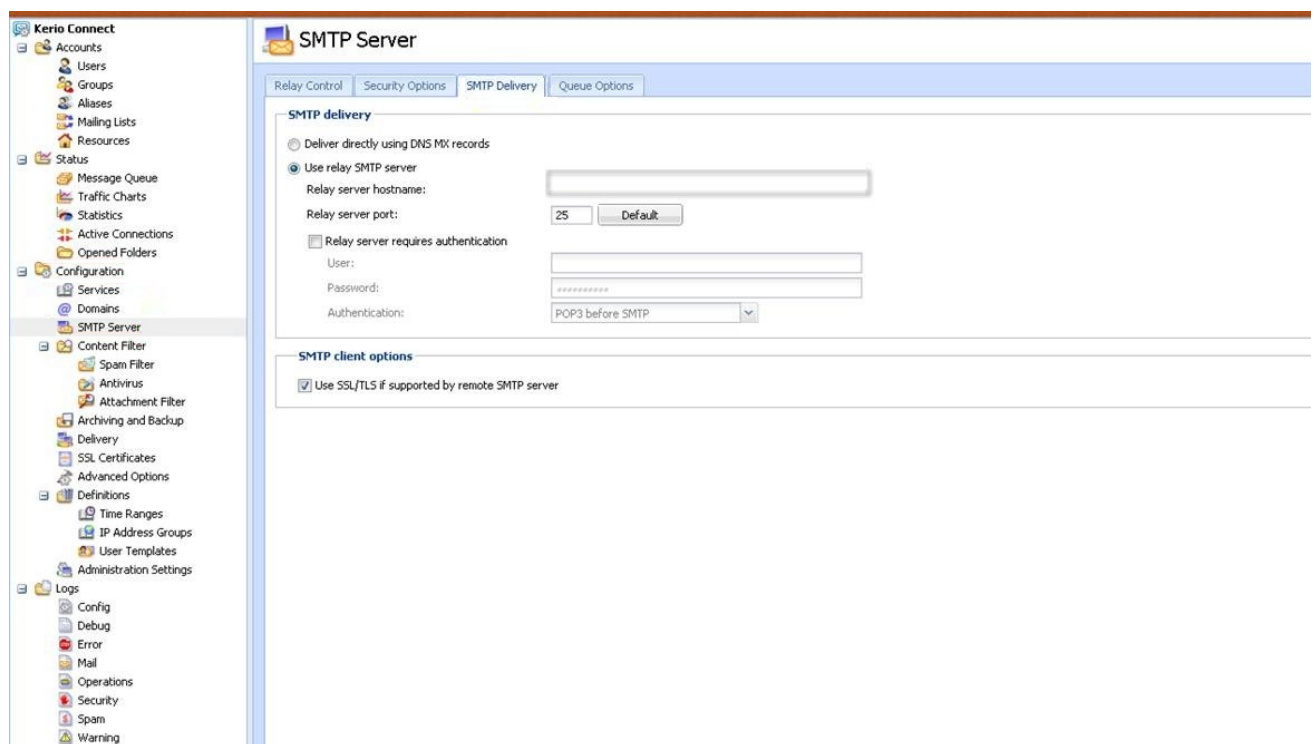


How to Route Outbound Mail from Kerio Connect Mail Server through the Barracuda Email Security Gateway

Use the following steps to route outbound mail from the Kerio Connect Mail Server through the Barracuda Email Security Gateway.

1. Navigate to the Kerio Connect directory, expand **Configuration**, and click **SMTP Server**.
2. In the **SMTP Delivery** tab, select **Use relay SMTP server**, and enter the Barracuda Email Security Gateway IP address.
3. Enter the **Relay server port** number.
4. Turn on **Use SSL/TLS if supported by remote SMTP server**.
