

Policy Schedules

This article refers to the Barracuda PST Enterprise version 3.1 or higher.

You can set a schedule for each PST on the **Assign Policy** dialog in the **Assigned PSTs** page. Define the processing start and end date, as well as the start and end time. When the PST Enterprise Client considers processing a PST, it does not start if the current time is before the scheduling start time for the PST or after its end time.

To set the schedule,

1. Go to the **Assign PSTs** page. If you want to assign a policy to a set of PSTs, select one or more PSTs in the table.
2. Click **Assign Policy**. In the dialog box, select the policy from the drop-down menu.
3. Click **Start the policy at a schedule time**, and then set the **Start** and **End** dates and times:
