You can set a schedule for each PST on the **Assign Policy** dialog in the **Assigned PSTs** page. Define the processing start and end date, as well as the start and end time. When the PST Enterprise Client considers processing a PST, it does not start if the current time is before the scheduling start time for the PST or after its end time.


To set the schedule,

- 1. Go to the **Assign PSTs** page. If you want to assign a policy to a set of PSTs, select one or more PSTs in the table.
- 2. Click **Assign Policy**. In the dialog box, select the policy from the drop-down menu.
- 3. Click Start the policy at a schedule time, and then set the Start and End dates and times:

- 4. Click **Assign to selected PSTs** to assign to only those PSTs currently selected in the table, or click **Assign to all PSTs** to assign the policy to all PSTs currently shown in the table.
- 5. The schedule is added to the selected PSTs, and the start and end dates and times display in the **Schedule Start/Schedule End** columns in the table.
