


## Archive Location Page - No Storage Manager

The **Archive Location** page displays in the **Configuration Wizard** if you are *not* using a third-party **Installing a Storage Manager**. Use this page to configure the Archive Base Directory. This can be changed after archiving is complete, however, you must move all files and directories under the original Archive Base Directory to the new Archive Base Directory to avoid corrupting the archive:
