The Barracuda NG Firewall Mail Gateway service lets you set up a powerful and secure mail gateway. The Mail Gateway service configuration provides antivirus integration. In addition, you can configure POP3 scanning, content stripping, grey listing, and blacklists. The Mail Gateway service generates log files, which can be viewed in the **Logs** interface.

Mail Gateway Configuration

Let the Barracuda NG Firewall interact with an operating mail server in your internal LAN or configure the Barracuda NG Firewall as a standalone SMTP host. Enable the Mail Gateway service, set up your domains, and define policies by setting up custom rules for traffic that passes the mail gateway.
