

How to Enable the Barracuda Web Filter

The Barracuda Web Filter (a.k.a. URL Filter) is used in combination with Application Control 2.0 in the Firewall service. A valid Energize Subscription is necessary to use the Barracuda URL Filter.

In this article

Enable the URL Filter Service

1. Go to **CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Box > Infrastructure Services > General Firewall Configuration**.
2. Click **Lock**.
3. In the left menu, click **Application Detection**.
4. Set the **Working Mode** to **On**.

5. Click **Send Changes** and **Activate**.
