

How to Add Users from a Child Domain

Use the following steps to grant ArchiveOne admin permissions to users in a different domain:

- 1. From a Domain Controller, open Active Directory Users and Computers (ADUC).
- 2. Right-click the Global Security group **ArchiveOneUsers** in the root domain, and click **Properties**. This group is found by default in the **Users** container.

ArchiveOneUsers is the default Global Security group name. If you <u>changed the Global Security group name</u>, select that name instead.

- 3. In ADUC, expand the child domain where the user resides.
- 4. In a suitable container, for example, **Users**, right-click and select **New > Group**.
- 5. Create a new Global Security group with the same name, by default, **ArchiveOneUsers**, as the existing Security group in the root domain.
- 6. Click OK.
- 7. Right-click the newly created Security group, and click **Properties**.
- 8. On the **Members** tab, click **Add** and select the user account(s) from the child domain to which to grand ArchiveOne admin permissions.
- 9. Click **OK** to save the group membership.
- 10. Open the ArchiveOne Admin console.
- 11. Click the Roles and Users node, and then click Users
- 12. Confirm the new users are listed in the form ChildDomain\Username.
