## How to Update the Barracuda VPN Client for macOS

Before updating the Barracuda VPN Client for macOS, read the **Release Notes** from the latest version to learn about any possible changes.

Update the Barracuda VPN Client for macOS and all of its components from an older 3.x version to a newer one. You can receive updates for the Barracuda VPN Client via the **Main Menu** or conventional distribution methods. Install the updates upon receipt.

---

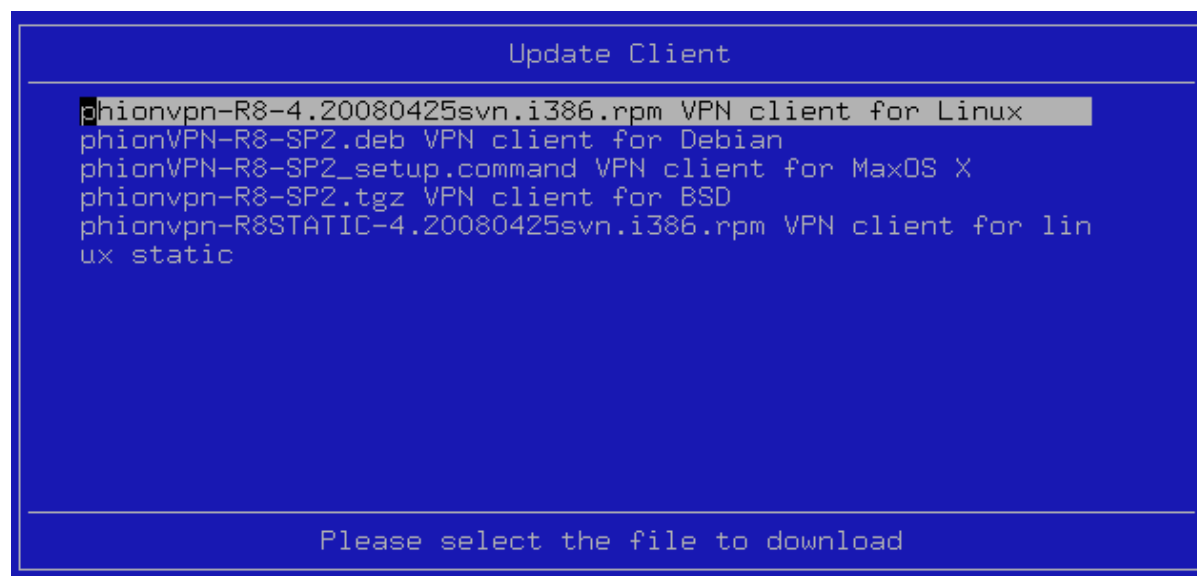
To update the macOS GUI version of the Barracuda VPN client, see [Installing the Barracuda VPN Client for macOS](#) and follow the instructions for a fresh installation. The new version will replace your existing version without the loss of any settings.

### Update the Barracuda VPN Client for macOS Command Line

---

To update the macOS version of the Barracuda VPN Client from the command line:

1. Load the update onto your machine. Downloads are saved in the `/tmp/` folder.
2. From the **Main Menu**, select **Update Client**.
3. Select the update file to download.



To update the Linux and macOS command-line version of the Barracuda VPN Client via conventional distribution methods, such as email or disk, follow the instructions provided in [How to Update the Barracuda VPN Client for Linux](#).
