To authenticate users connected to Ruckus access points, you must stream the syslog containing the authentication data to the Barracuda NextGen Firewall X-Series.


Reference Devices/Versions:

Step 1. Enable Syslog Streaming on the Ruckus Wireless AP

Enable Client Association in the debug log settings.

- 1. Go to **Administer > Diagnostics.**
- 2. In the **Debug Logs** section, enable **Client Association**.
- 3. Click Apply.



Step 2. Enable Syslog Streaming on the Ruckus Wireless AP

- 1. Go to Configure > System Log Settings.
- 2. Enable the Remote Syslog.
- 3. Enter the IP address of the X-Series Firewall.

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4. Click Apply.

You can now configure Wi-Fi Access Point authentication on the X-Series Firewall. For more information, see <u>How to Configure Wi-Fi Access Point Authentication</u>.
