

## How to Configure a Remote Desktop Resource for SSL VPN

After you configure the SSL VPN service, you can create remote desktop or RDP resources for it.

Note that the RDP applet only supports native Microsoft RDP based remote connections.

### Configure a Remote Desktop Resource

1. Go to **CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Box > Virtual Servers > your virtual server > Assigned Services > VPN-Service > SSL-VPN.**
2. In the left menu, select **Applications / Tunnels.**
3. Click **Lock.**
4. In the **Applications** table, add an entry for each resource. For each entry, you can specify the following settings:

Setting	Description
<b>Name</b>	The name for the resource. For example, RDP
<b>Visible Name</b>	The name that is displayed in the SSL Portal for the resource.
<b>Application Server IP</b>	The IP address. For example, 10.10.10.18

5. Click **OK.**
6. Click **Send Changes** and **Activate.**

You can also create the following types of resources:
