

# **Dynamic Network Start and Stop Scripts**

Dynamic network connections may be stopped and started directly through the command-line interface.

#### **xDSL Connections**

- Start all xDSL connections: /etc/phion/bin/openxdsl start
- Stop all xDSL connections: /etc/phion/bin/wipexdsl
- Start a specific xDSL connection: /etc/phion/bin/openxdsl start linkname>
- Stop a specific xDSL connection: /etc/phion/bin/wipexdsl stop linkname>

#### **DHCP Connections**

- Start all DHCP connections: /etc/phion/bin/openxdhcp start
- Stop all DHCP connections: /etc/phion/bin/wipexdhcp
- Start a specific DHCP connection: /etc/phion/bin/openxdhcp start linkname>
- Stop a specific DHCP connection: /etc/phion/bin/wipexdhcp stop linkname>

#### **ISDN Connections**

- Start ISDN connections: /etc/phion/bin/openisdn start
- Stop ISDN connections: /etc/phion/bin/wipeisdn

### **UMTS Connections**

- Start UMTS connection: /etc/phion/bin/startumts
- Stop UMTS connection: /etc/phion/bin/wipeumts
