
Verification of Certification

3. Select "Certification Verification URL".




Incomplete Certifications - Goals



How can I renew an expired certificate?

Extending an expired certificate is possible at any time, even prior to the date of expiration. To renew a certificate, go to "*Certificates*" and click the "*Expired*" tab. Select "*Renew*" next to the certificate you wish to extend.



If an expired certificate is labeled with "Legacy" , click on the certificate name. You will be redirected to the replacement certificate.

Can I take my certificates with me when I change companies?

The certification on Barracuda Campus is exclusive to your account. If you have changed your company and email address, you will primarily need a new account with your new email address (See [How to Log In](#)). After you have logged into Campus at least once, contact us at campus@barracuda.com and request to merge the accounts. To have your certificates transferred, you will need to provide Barracuda Campus with the following information:

- Previous email address, used in the old company
- New email address
- Name and address of the new company

It is not possible to transfer certificates to private e-mail addresses, addresses from public providers (such as Gmail, Hotmail or Yahoo) or shared bulk addresses like support@, IT@, etc. It is also not possible to transfer certificates from one of these accounts to a personal company account.
