Devices Statistics

In this view, the traffic and performance statistics available on the **BASIC > Dashboard** page of your Barracuda Web Application Firewall will be displayed. If multiple Barracuda Web Application Firewall devices are connected, the aggregated statistics of all the connected devices are displayed.

Security and Traffic Reports

The **BASIC** > **Reports** page provides an aggregated report of all the Barracuda Web Application Firewall devices connected to the Barracuda WAF Control Center. Alerts

The **BASIC** > **Alerts** page displays the alerts generated by the Barracuda Web Application Firewall devices connected to the Barracuda WAF Control Center. You can customize the display of alerts and configure the threshold for email alerts by using Preferences.

The **BASIC** > **Certificates** page allows users to manage certificates, including expired certificates, across all connected devices.
