For maximum security, Barracuda Networks recommends reviewing <u>Securing the Barracuda Web Security Gateway</u> after installation.

Recommended Steps

If you already installed your Barracuda Web Security Gateway using the <u>Barracuda Web Security Gateway Quick Start Guide</u>, which is shipped with your appliance, start with <u>Step 3 - Configure the Barracuda Web Security Gateway</u>. If you are using the Barracuda Web Security Gateway Vx, start with <u>Virtual Deployment</u>.

Best Practices in Configuring Policy

After you complete the basic setup of your Barracuda Web Security Gateway, you can fine tune your block/accept policies. See <u>Best Practices in Configuring Policy</u> for guidance.

Integration with External Systems and Services - Security Considerations

The Barracuda Web Security Gateway integrates with other systems and services in your environment, like your LDAP server and mail servers. Barracuda Networks recommends creating separate service accounts for these integration points, rather than personal accounts, and then using the principle of least privilege. This integration strategy is part of an overall security policy. For more information, see <u>Security for Integrating with Other Systems - Best Practices</u>.
