The F-Series Firewall can be deployed to the Google Cloud Platform to secure and connect your cloud resources. The NextGen Firewall can be deployed either by uploading the disk image available from the Barracuda download portal, or by using the marketplace image in Google Launcher.

### Deploy via Google Launcher

---

You can deploy the latest firmware version of the F-Series Firewall directly from Google Launcher. You must bring your own licenses (BYOL), PAYG images are not available.

### Manually upload an image and deploy

If you need to deploy a firmware version of the F-Series Firewall that is not available through Google Launcher, you can manually upload and deploy the firewall images.
