


How to Disable Auto-Complete for Popular Search Engines

Blocking these URL patterns disables auto-complete for each search engine. Add these patterns manually to the **BLOCK/ACCEPT > URL Patterns** page if you want to disable auto-complete:

Search Engine	URL Pattern to Block
Google	www.google.com/complete/
Yahoo	search.yahoo.com/sugg/
Bing	www.bing.com/AS/Suggestions?

For example, the following two URL pattern entries on the **BLOCK/ACCEPT > URL Patterns** page disable auto-complete for Google and Yahoo.
