

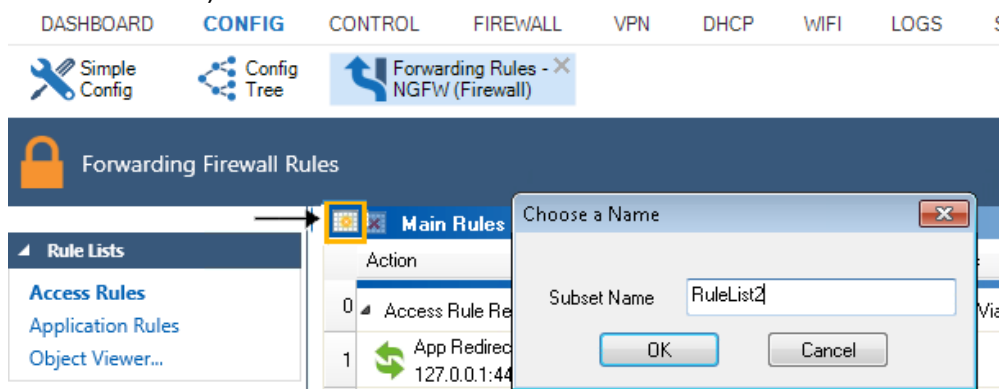
How to Create New Rule Lists

For a better overview and organization of your access rule set, you can create additional rule lists to assigning rules a main or sub-priority within the forwarding rule set. You can apply the additional rule lists to traffic by creating a Cascade access rule. For more information, see [How to Create Cascade and Cascade Back Access Rules](#).

Create a Rule List

1. Go to **CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Box > Virtual Servers > your virtual server > Assigned Services > Firewall > Forwarding Rules**.
2. Click **Lock**.
3. On the **Access Rules** page, click the yellow table icon in the top left of the rule set (next to **Main Rules**).



4. Enter a name for the rule list and click **OK**.
5. Click **Send Changes** and **Activate**.

After the rule list is created, a tab for it appears next to the **Main Rules** tab on top of the list.



In the new rule list, you can now specify a range of access rules. To switch between rule lists, click the tabs. You can also copy a rule from the main rule list by right-clicking the rule and selecting **Copy** and then right-clicking the additional rule list and selecting **Paste**.
