### Barracuda Email Security Service

- Specify the Barracuda Email Security Service as an *inbound mail gateway* so that Barracuda Email Security Service filters out spam and viruses, and then passes the mail on to your Exchange mail service.
- Specify the Barracuda Email Security Service as the *outbound mail gateway* so that the Barracuda Email Security Service processes the mail by filtering out spam and viruses before final delivery.

### Advanced Threat Protection

- Protects against advanced malware, zero-day exploits, and targeted attacks not detected by the Barracuda Email Security Service virus scanning features.
