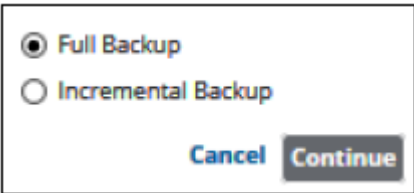
The backup running and stop icons are displayed while the backup is running.



Manually Running a Backup Set

To run a backup manually, perform the following steps.

1. At the Backup Selections page, click the play  button in the Run column. Depending on the backup type, the run Full or Incremental pop up is displayed.



2. Make your selection, and then click **Continue**. The backup begins to run, and status is displayed.
