The center of the Dashboard page is divided into the following panes, displaying data for the last 24 hours:

- Blocked Requests by Category: Malware Displays traffic blocked in the Malware category.
- Blocked Requests by Category: Spyware Displays traffic blocked in the Spyware category.
- **Blocked Requests by Category:Phishing** Displays traffic blocked in the *Phishing & Fraud* categories.
- Total Blocked Requests Displays the total number of blocked requests.

These statistics indicate what kind of activity is being blocked for your clients. Tune your policies as needed on the **DNS Filtering** page, as described in <u>How to Configure DNS Filtering and Policies</u>. Also see <u>Best Practices for Creating DNS Policies</u> and <u>Best Practices for DNS Filtering Deployment</u>.

The top right pane displays Subscriptions by type, number of licenses, and expiration date.

The lower right pane of the page displays the **Blocked Supercategories** and the **Top Blocked Categories** tabs. Click on either tab to view the **Count** and **Trend** of number of requests blocked by category or supercategory.

- Adjust the time frame for the **Blocked Supercategories** and the **Top Blocked Categories** tabs: At the bottom of the right pane, select **Last 24 hours**, **Last 7 days**, or **Last 14 days**.
- Create and view reports: click **View Report** at the bottom of the right pane to go to the Reports page. See Reports for details.

- **Reports** Create or schedule reports on Blocked Categories or Blocked Supercategories . See <u>Reports</u> for details.
- Alerts Create notifications to specific recipients based on a selected event (Notification Type).

- **Account Settings** Upload a custom logo to display on reports and on blocked pages displayed to end users.
- **Block Page** Use this page to customize the message in the block page the user sees when a website is blocked due to configured policy.
