

## Audit Logs

All configuration changes within Barracuda WAF-as-a-Service are captured in the Audit Logs. Click **Audit Logs** along the top menu from almost anywhere within Barracuda WAF-as-a-Service to see configuration activity.

For other types of logging, refer to [Access, Firewall, and Event Logs](#)

You can narrow down the log entries displayed by using these options:

- **Search** – Enter one or more full or partial words to search for specific text within a record.
- **Date** – Select a standard date range (like **Last 7 Days** or **Last 30 Days**) or create a custom date range.
- **Filter** – Select one or more filters and specify the values you want to display. Click **Clear** to remove all filters.
  - **User** – Select a user from the list.
  - **Application** – Select an application from the list.
  - **Component** – Select a component, like Cookie Security.
  - **By API** – Select **True** to see activity that was conducted via APIs.
  - **By Support System** – Select **True** to see activity conducted by Barracuda Networks Technical Support.
  - **By VRS** – Select **True** to view activity associated with automated remediation through the Barracuda Vulnerability Remediation Service.
  - **Marked as False Positive** – Select **True** to view activity associated with firewall log entries that were Marked as False Positive.

Click **Download** to export the displayed Audit Log records to a CSV file.
