

## Setting Up Monitoring

Although the Infrascale service module is free, if you want to do bare metal backups on workstations and servers, or install an appliance for specialized backups, you must contact your sales representative to purchase licenses. Additionally, for file and folder backups, you must purchase a disk quota that you can then allocate to your customer sites.

To calculate the disk quota you need across all sites, allocate approximately 25GB per device for file and folder backups, and 250GB per device for bare metal backups. You can choose to automatically allow backup accounts to go over quota, and you can contact your sales representative to purchase additional disk quota.

To set up monitoring, you must do the following procedures:

- You cannot use both file and folder backup and bare metal backups on the same device.
