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## Rebooting Device Managers

If a reboot is required during the installation or upgrading of Device Managers, and the reboot does not occur, you can force a reboot from Service Center. By forcing a reboot, a reboot script is run on the device and starts within a minute. The user does not have time to save any open work nor is allowed to stop the reboot. Once the system reboots, the installation or upgrade completes.

### To reboot all Device Managers at more than one site

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1. In Service Center, click **Update Center > Products**.
2. Select the check boxes for the sites where you want Device Managers rebooted.
3. Click **More Actions**.
4. Click **Reboot Device Managers in Pending Reboot**.

### To reboot specific Device Managers at one site

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1. In Service Center, click **Site Management > Sites**.
2. Click the name of the site where you want to reboot Device Managers.
3. Click the **Device Managers** tab.
4. Select the check boxes for the Device Managers you want to reboot.
5. Click **More Actions**.
6. Click **Reboot Device Managers in Pending Reboot**.

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
