

## When Your Energize Updates Subscription Expires

You should keep your Energize Updates subscription current in order to continue applying the latest security definitions to your Barracuda Web Application Firewall and protect your network and users. The Barracuda Web Application Firewall will prompt you with a message at the top of the **BASIC > Dashboard** page before the subscription expires.

The table provides the details of the impact the expiry of Energize Updates subscription has on the capabilities of the Web Application Firewall in the different form factors.

On the **ADVANCED > Energize Updates** page,

- The Identity theft patterns, attack patterns, patterns for input data types and parameter class will not be updated nor newly added.
