

Try This—Improving your Site Security Score

If you want to try improving your Site Security Score, choose a test where you have a lower score and take the suggested countermeasure. The next time the Site Security Assessment runs, your score improves.

For example, if you have a score of 50% score on the **Software updates evaluation - Service packs** test, you can improve this score by installing service packs on devices that don't have them.

1. Click the arrow next to the test, then click the number link next to **Devices at risk** for a list of devices.
2. Install the required service packs on the devices.

The next time a Site Security Assessment runs, you can see an improvement in your score and the percentage improvement is displayed in the **Patch Security** category box.
