

Adding an AMQP/AMQPS Server

Perform the following steps to add an AMQP/AMQPS server:

1. Go to the **ADVANCED > Export Logs** page.
2. In the **Export Logs** section, click **Add Export Log Server**. The **Add Export Log Server** window opens. Specify values for the following:
 - **Name** – Enter a name for the AMQP server.
 - **Log Server Type** – Select **AMQP/AMQPS**.
 - **IP Address or Hostname** – Enter the IP address or the hostname of the AMQP/AMQPS server.
 - **Port** – Enter the port associated with the IP address of the AMQP/AMQPS server.
 - **Username** – Enter the username to be used to authenticate to the AMQP/AMQPS server.
 - **Password** – Enter the password to be used for the above user account.
As a best practice, use a unique account for this integration point and grant it the least level of privileges required, coordinating with the AMQP/AMQPS administrator. This account requires WRITE privileges on the AMQP/AMQPS server *only for the specific path you indicate* in the next field.  - **Event Queue Name** – Enter the queue name configured on the AMQP/AMQPS server to which logs needs to be exported.
 - **Log Timestamp and Hostname** – Set to **Yes** if you want to log the date and time of the event, and the hostname configured on the **BASIC > IP Configuration > Domain Configuration** section.
3. Click **Add**.
