

## **Adding a Loggly Cloud Syslog Server**

Perform the following steps to add a Loggly Cloud Syslog server:

- 1. Go to the **ADVANCED** > **Export Logs** page.
- 2. In the **Add Export Log Server** window, specify values for the following:
  - **Name** Enter a name for the Loggly service.
  - Log Server Type Select CloudSyslog Service.
  - **IP Address or Hostname** Enter the IP address or the hostname of the Loggly service. For example: *logs-01.loggly.com*
  - **Port** Enter the port associated with the IP address of the Loggly service.
  - Token Enter the token for Loggly service. For example: 0a7c8023-92a7-4c9c-90f3-2d18453fdafa@41058, where 41058 is the Loggly ID that should be mentioned after the token.
  - Log Timestamp and Hostname Set to Yes if you want to log the date and time of the event, and the hostname configured on the BASIC > IP Configuration > Domain Configuration section.
  - **Comment** (Optional) Enter comment about the new setting.
- 3. Click Add.
