Cloud Connections (Accounts)	No action required	Your existing cloud connections (accounts and subscriptions) with AWS and Azure are now connected to the new version.
Security Policies	Default: No action required Custom: Migration required	If you only used <i>default security policies</i> , no action is required. Any <i>customized security policies</i> you might have created were not migrated to the new version. You can <ul style="list-style-type: none">• recreate them yourself, as described in Creating a Security Policy, or• contact CSG_Support@barracuda.com and a Barracuda engineer will assist you in migrating your policies
Deployed Firewalls and WAFs	Separate management	Any Barracuda Firewalls and WAFs that you might have deployed are still active, but for now, you cannot manage them from within Barracuda Cloud Security Guardian.
