


Deleting Physical Imaging Standard Revisions


Deleted data is completely purged immediately and can no longer be accessed or restored.


To delete the data of a Physical Imaging Standard revision, perform the following steps.


1. Navigate to the **Computer** page.
The **Computer** page is displayed.




2. Select the **Delete** tab.
The **Delete Selections** page is displayed.



3. Select the delete  icon beside the backup type you want to delete.
The **Delete Backup** page is displayed.



4. Select the check box of the volume/revision you want to delete.
The selections for deletion are displayed in the right panel.



- When satisfied with your selection, click the **Delete** button.
The **Delete Confirmation** pop-up is displayed.

☐ **Retain backup data for 7 days.**
