To delete a Hyper-V Standard revision, perform the following steps.


1. Navigate to the **Computer** page.



Hyper-V Standard Delete Options

Hyper-V Standard backup sets use deduplication and block-level processing. For these backup sets, the following options are available on the **Delete Selection** screen:

- Retain backup data for 7 days
- Delete all deduplication data

Retain Backup Data for 7 Days

By selecting the **Retain backup data for 7 days** check box, you can retain deleted data in your Local Vault and the cloud for deduplication purposes for seven days. At the end of seven days, this data is deleted.

This option is useful if you are backing up VMs on this machine and would like to use the existing blocks for de-duplication purposes.

If you choose not to select this option, the data that you have selected is deleted from the Local Vault and the cloud immediately.

Delete All Deduplication Data



By selecting the **Delete all deduplication data** check box, you can immediately delete any deduplication data not being used. This option is useful if you do not want to use existing blocks for de-duplication purposes anymore and you want to delete them immediately.

You cannot select both check boxes at the same time; selecting one disables the other.
