

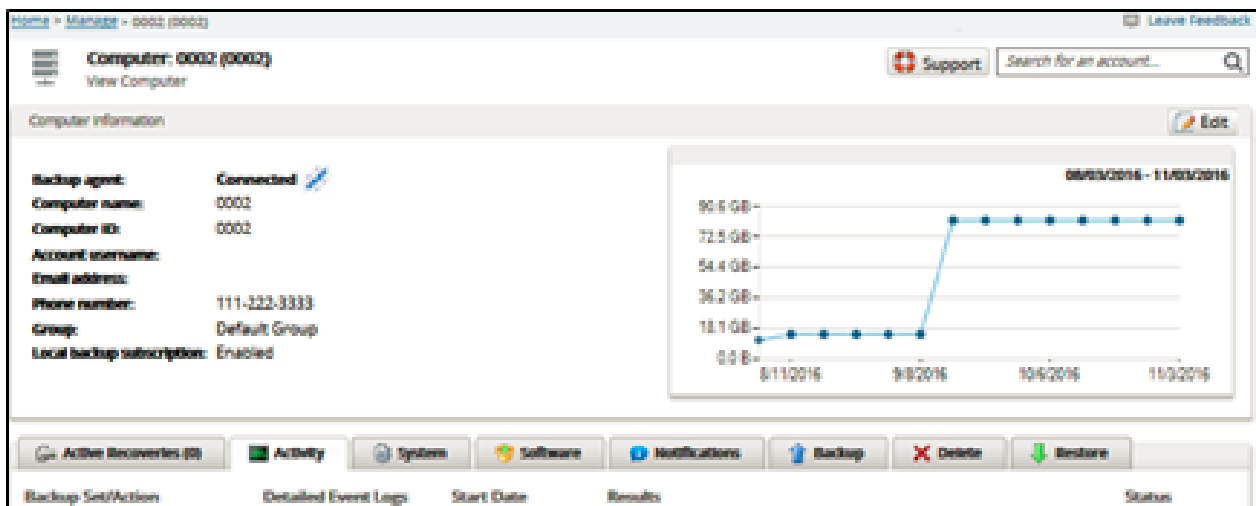
Restoring an Exchange Mailbox Level Backup

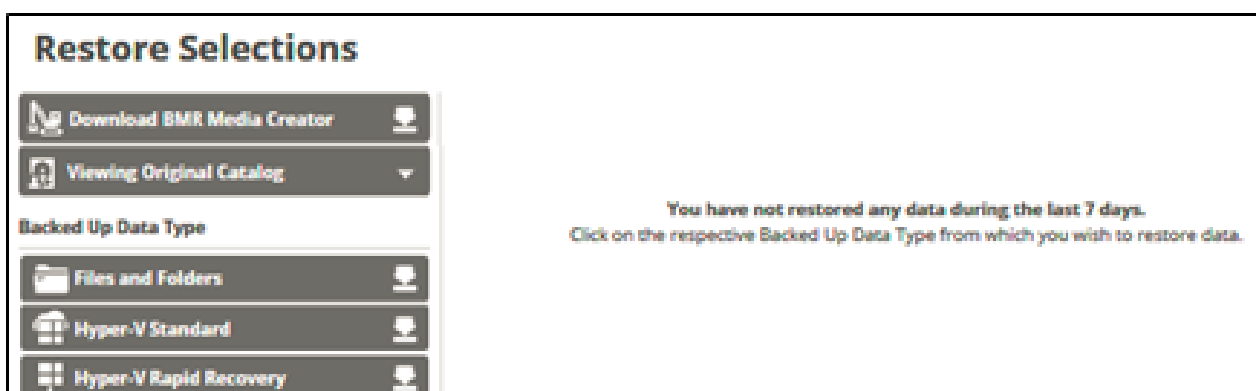
This article provides the steps to restore individual messages, specific folders, or entire mailboxes from an Exchange Mailbox Level backup set. Depending on the purpose for the restore, you may want to restore the mail back into Exchange or restore it outside, in the form of individual message files or a (.pst) file.

To restore an Exchange Mailbox Level backup, perform the following steps.

1. Log in to the [management portal](#) and navigate to the Computer page. See [Navigating to the Computer Page](#) for instructions.
The Computer page is displayed.



2. Click the **Restore** tab.
The Restore Selections page is displayed.



3. Click **Exchange Mailbox Level**.
The Select page is displayed

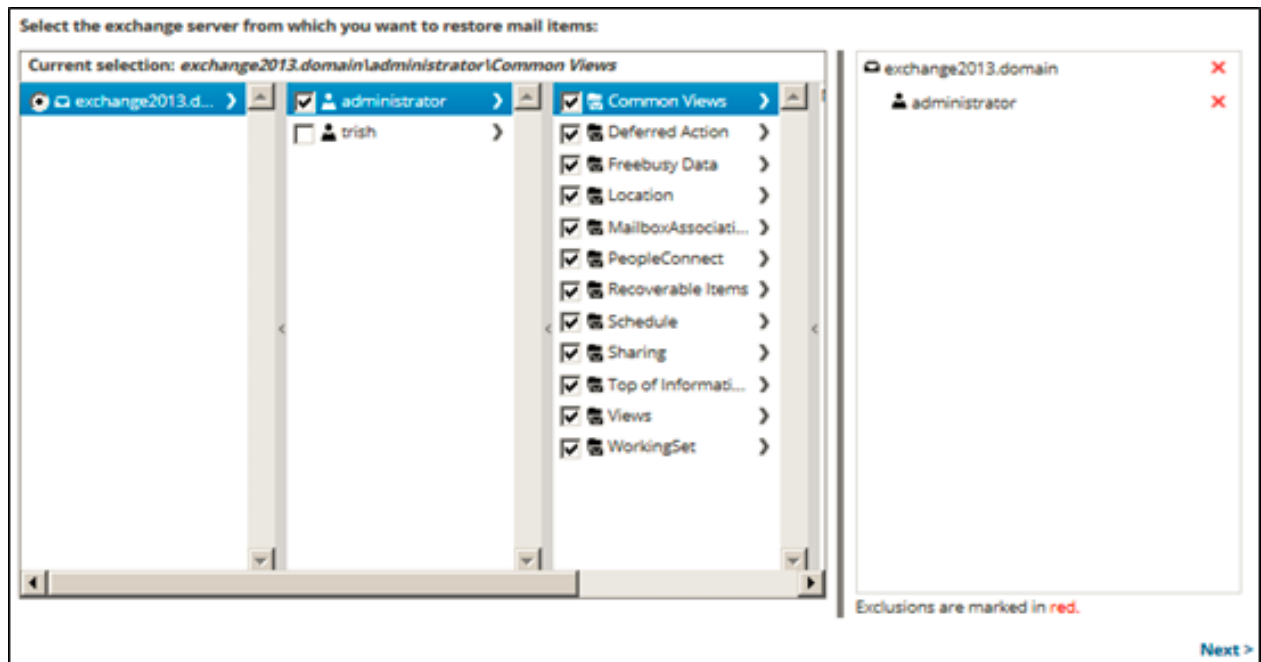

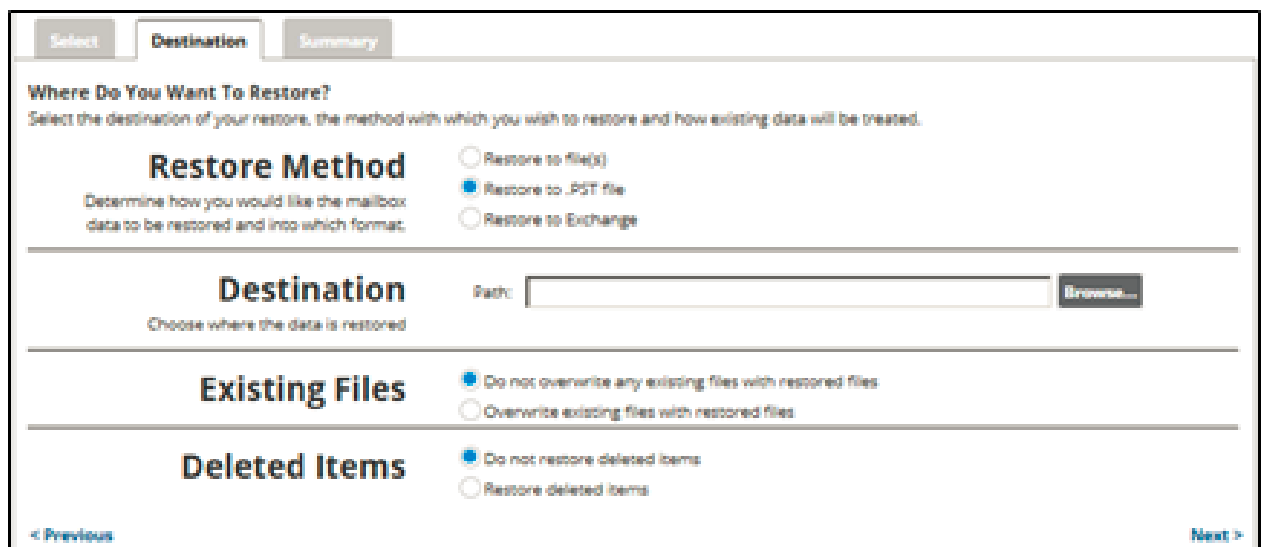
4. In the Current Selection pane, select the mailboxes to be restored.
5. Clicking the arrow  at the right of the items displays more mailboxes.
The selection is displayed in the far-right pane. Click the remove icon  to remove any selections.



Note: You can only restore from one Exchange Server at a time.

6. After confirming your selections, click **Next**.


The Destination page is displayed.



7. Select a Restore Method radio button.

If you select **Restore to file(s)** or **Restore to .PST file**, then at the Destination path field, type a path, or click the **Browse** button, and select a destination for the restored file(s). See [Browsing to a Folder](#).

If you select **Restore to Exchange**, the following fields are displayed.




8. At the Existing Files section, select either **Do not overwrite any existing files with restored files** or **Overwrite existing files with restored files** radio button,
9. At the Deleted Items section, select **Do not restore deleted items** or **Restore deleted items**, and then click **Next**.

The Restore Summary page is displayed.



10. Verify the restore selections, and then click **Restore**.
The confirmation pop-up is displayed.



11. Click **Yes**.
The Restore Selections page is displayed with the status.
