- [Using Quick Launch](#) - When creating a campaign, look for campaigns with titles that start with *13 Threat Types*.
 - *Training campaigns* include a video to teach your users about the email threat types.
 - *Testing campaigns* use the email threat type in the simulation, and also include the video used for training.
- [Using an Email Campaign](#) - When you create the email campaign, enable Content Groups. When adding the Content Group, use the filter in the left panel to search for the Category called *13 Threats*.

Create the campaigns as you usually would, following the instructions for either Quick Launch or Creating an Email Campaign.
