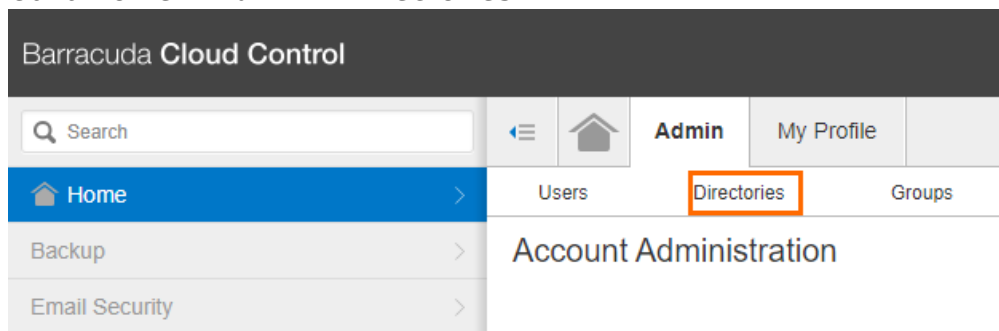

Before You Begin

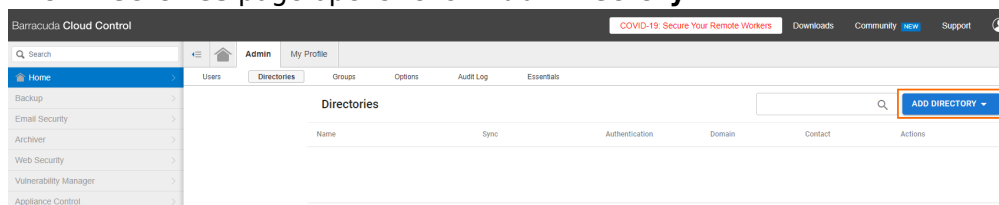
- The Azure Active Directory you are connecting to in the following steps must be the same Azure Active Directory configured in <https://cloudgenwan.barracudanetworks.com/>.
- You must have administration privileges for Barracuda Cloud Control.

Synchronize Your Barracuda Cloud Control with Azure Active Directory

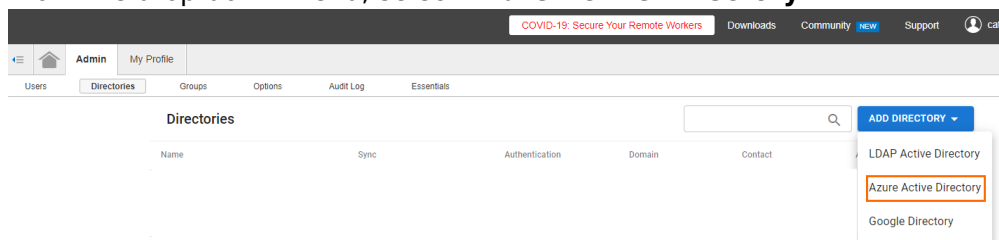
1. Log into <https://login.barracudanetworks.com/>.
2. Go to **Home > Admin > Directories**.




3. The **Directories** page opens. Click **Add Directory**.



4. From the drop-down menu, select **Azure Active Directory**.



5. The **Create Directory: New Azure AD** window opens.
6. In the **INFO** tab specify values for the following:
 - **Directory Name** – Enter a name.
 - **User / Group Sync** – Click to enable.
 - **Authentication** – Click to enable.



7. Click **CONNECT TO MICROSOFT**.
8. You are redirected to Microsoft Azure. Read the requested permission and scroll down.
