

Advanced Software Management: Patching a Single Application or Applications from a Single Vendor

If you want to use Advanced Software Management to install all the patches for a specific application or all the applications for a specific vendor, follow the procedures below.

Following this procedure results in a one-time install. Automatic software approval can only be set up according to patch severity, not vendor or application.

Advanced Software Management must be enabled for you to patch third-party applications. To purchase an Advanced Software Management license, contact your Barracuda sales representative.

Identify the patches to install

1. In Service Center, click **Advanced Software Management > Manual Software Approval**.
2. If **Advanced Filtering** is not displayed, click the **Advanced Filtering** button.
3. In the **Advanced Filtering** section, do the following:
 - In the **Vendor** box, select the name of the software manufacturer.
 - If desired, select the software application's name in the **Product** box.
 - In the **Approval** box, select **Not Approved**.
4. Click **Apply**.
5. Select the checkboxes of the patches you want to approve.
6. Click **Change Approvals**.
7. In the **Approval** box, select **Install**.
8. Click **OK**.

Set up the schedule and devices to install on

Barracuda RMM Support Note

If you use auto-application rules, ensure your policy is a member of an active service, or the rules will not be applied. If you use manual application, this is not required.

1. In Service Center, click **Service Delivery > Policies > Advanced Software Management**.
2. Click **New** to create a policy, or click the name of an existing policy.
3. Click the **Settings** tab.
4. Click **Modify**.
5. Do one of the following:
 - Select the **Install as per applicable Execution Schedule** button.
 - Select the **Override Execution Schedules** checkbox and set the schedule.
6. Click **Save**.

7. Do one of the following:

- Click the **Auto-Application** tab, then add the rules to select your devices.
- Click the **Manual Application** tab, click either of the **Add** buttons and add groups and devices.

8. Click **Save**.
