

How to Set Up a Windows Share

To enable a Windows share:

1. [Add a resource](#) in which the public and internal host are the name of the share.
2. Enable ports 137, 138, 139, and 445.
3. Select TCP/UDP as a protocol.

If you are using an Entra ID domain, the name of the share should be the name of the machine suffixed by the Entra ID domain. For example:

`\\machinewithshare.windomain.int\ShareName.`

In this case, `machinewithshare` is the name of the machine hosting the share folders and `windomain.int` is the Entra ID domain. The domain name to add as a resource would be `machinewithshare.windomain.int`.
