

How to Configure the Consistency Verification for Network Configurations

Integrity Check lets you select between different options for doing a logical test of the network configuration before it is activated.

This option is available only in **Advanced Configuration Mode**.

Step 1. Switch to Advanced Configuration Mode

- 1. Log into your firewall.
- 2. Go to CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Box > Network.
- 3. In the left menu list, click **Configuration Mode** and select **Switch to Advanced**.



4. The left menu is now displayed in **Advanced Mode** and contains the list entry **Integrity Check**.

Step 2. Configure the Integrity Check

1. Click Integrity Check in the left menu list.



- 2. For **Consistency Verification**, select from the list:
 - 1. **Always** Perform a consistency check after every configuration change.
 - 2. Box-Only A consistency check is performed only on changes made on the box layer.
 - 3. **Never** The consistency check is never performed.
- 3. For **Include Shared IPs**, select **yes** if you want to include shared IP addresses in the logical test.
