

How to Manually Upload Files to ATP


In some cases, you might have to manually check files using ATP. You can upload a file through Barracuda Firewall Admin. Optionally, an email notification is sent when the scan has been completed.

Before You Begin

- Enable ATP. For more information, see [How to Configure ATP in the Firewall](#).
- To receive a notification email, you must configure the system notification email address. For more information, see [How to Configure System Email Notifications](#).

Step 1. Upload the File

1. Open the **ATP** tab.
2. Click **Manual File Upload**. The **ATP File Upload** window opens.
3. Click **Choose File** and select the file you want to upload.
4. (optional) Enable **get notified via Email**.
5. (optional) Enter the notification email.

6. Click **Upload and Submit**.

Step 2. (optional) Download the Scan Report

After the file was scanned it is displayed on the **Scanned Files** page from where you can download the scan report.

4. Click **Download Report** on the top right of the page.
5. Select the report type:
 - **Summary Report**
 - **Full Report**
6. Save the report to your desired location.
