Enable Own Network Objects on Range/Cluster Level

- 1. Log into your Control Center.
- 2. Go to CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Your Range/Cluster > Range/Cluster Properties
- 3. Click **Lock**.

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4. In the Specific Settings section, set Own Firewall Objects to yes.

- 6. Go to CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Your Range/Cluster > Range/Cluster Settings > Range/Cluster Firewall Objects
