

Enable Own Network Objects on Range/Cluster Level

1. Log into your Control Center.
2. Go to **CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Your Range/Cluster > Range/Cluster Properties**
3. Click **Lock**.
4. In the **Specific Settings** section, set **Own Firewall Objects** to **yes**.

5. Click **Send Changes** and **Activate**.
6. Go to **CONFIGURATION > Configuration Tree > Your Range/Cluster > Range/Cluster Settings > Range/Cluster Firewall Objects**
