

## vpnadminclt

To manage the VPN server, root users can use the **vpnadminclt** utility ( */opt/phion/bin/* ). Use the following syntax:

**vpnadminclt** <server>\_<service> <command>

### Commands

You can use the following commands with *vpnadminclt*:

Command	Description
<b>kill</b> <tunnel-name>	Terminates the specified site-to-site tunnel.
<b>ipsechardkill</b> <tunnel-name>	Terminates the specified IPsec site-to-site tunnel.
<b>init</b> <tunnel-name>	Establishes the specified tunnel.
<b>disable</b> <num> <tunnel-name>	Disables or enables the specified tunnel, as specified by the value of <b>num</b> where: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>num</b> : -1 - Disables the tunnel.</li> <li>• <b>num</b> : 0 - Enables the tunnel.</li> <li>• <b>num</b> &gt; 0 - Enable the tunnel for the specified &lt;num&gt; of seconds.</li> </ul>
<b>removestatus</b> <vpn-tunnelname>	Removes status information for a group VPN tunnel.
<b>showdynnum</b>	Shows dynamic number.
<b>--help</b>	Displays help information.
<b>killall vpnc</b>	Kills the tunnel. For example, if the "VPN point of entry" has been changed while the remote management tunnel is initialized and the box still uses the old tunnel. Repeat until the following message is displayed: "No Process killed"

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
