


## How to Configure Google Directory Authentication

OIDC authentication can be configured for enrolling devices through a specific identity provider.

### Configure Google Directory Authentication

1. Go to **Identity > Settings**.
2. In the **Authentication Protocol** section, click **Activate Provider**.
