

Getting Detailed Information on the Geographic Source of Incidents on the Security Overview

The **Incident Geo Source** section is an interactive map that shows you the countries that incidents originated from. To focus the map, you can drag it left and right, and zoom in and out. For more information on locations, you can hover your cursor over a city that is the source of incidents.



To choose the account displayed, see *To switch accounts* in <u>Navigating around Barracuda XDR</u> <u>Dashboard</u>.

To choose the timeframe displayed, see *To change the timeframe displayed on the Security Overview* procedure in <u>Changing the Date Range Displayed on the Security Overview</u>.

To filter the data, see using the *To create and apply a Security Overview filter* procedure in <u>Filtering the Security Overview</u>.



To zoom the map in or out

- 1. In Barracuda XDR Dashboard, click Intelligence > Security Overview.
- 2. To zoom in, in the **Incident Geo Source** section, click the 🛨 button in the top left corner or rotate the mouse wheel button forward.
- 3. To zoom out, in the **Incident Geo Source** section, click the **b**utton in the top left corner or rotate the mouse wheel button backward.

To scroll the map

When you are zoomed in to the map, you can scroll it. See Steps 1-2 in the *To zoom the map in or out* procedure above.

- 1. In Barracuda XDR Dashboard, click Intelligence > Security Overview.
- 2. In the **Incident Geo Source** section, do any of the following:
 - To scroll west, click the map and hold down the left mouse button while you drag right.
 - To scroll east, click the map and hold down the left mouse button while you drag left.
 - To scroll north, click the map and hold down the left mouse button while you drag up.
 - To scroll south, click the map and hold down the left mouse button while you drag down.

To view more information on cities that are sources of incidents

- 1. In Barracuda XDR Dashboard, click Intelligence > Security Overview.
- 2. In the Incident Geo Source section, hover your cursor over a city.
