

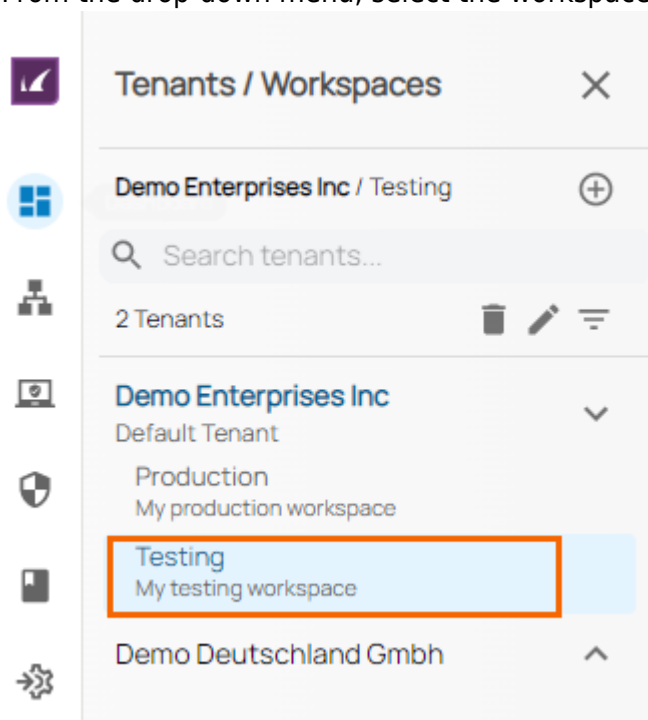
## How to Configure Points of Entry

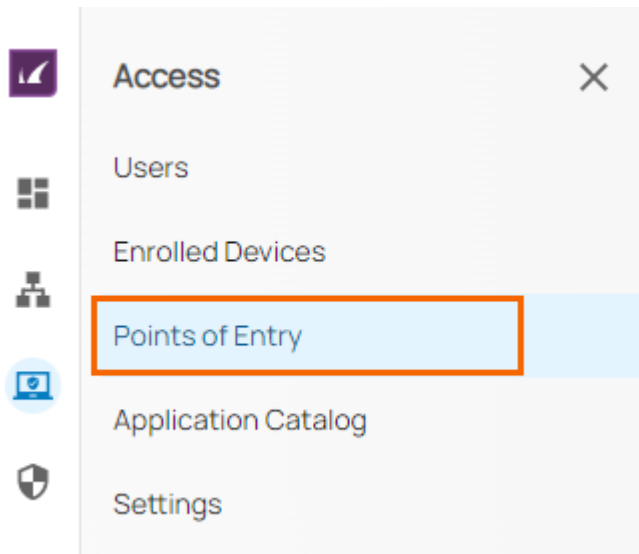
The Barracuda SecureEdge Manager allows administrators to enforce points of entry in the Barracuda SecureEdge environment. In Barracuda SecureEdge, you can configure three different types of points of entry: firewalls, edge services, and sites.

### Configure Points of Entry


1. Open <https://se.barracudanetworks.com/> in your web browser and log in with your existing Barracuda Cloud Control account.
2. In the left menu, click the **Tenants/Workspaces** icon.
3. From the drop-down menu, select the workspace your points of entry should be assigned to.



4. In the left menu, click the **Access** icon, and select **Points of Entry**.




5. The **Points of Entry** page opens. In the top-right corner of the window, click **Add points of entry**.

6. The **Add points of entry** page opens. Select a point of entry. You can choose among the following:
- **Firewalls** – Select the firewall from the drop-down list, or type to search.
  - **Edge Services** – Select the edge service from the drop-down list, or type to search.
  - **Sites** – Select the site from the drop-down list, or type to search.

7. Click **Save**.

## Edit an Existing Point of Entry

To edit an existing point of entry for a CloudGen Firewall:

1. Go to **Access > Points of Entry**.
2. Click on the pencil icon next to the firewall you want to edit.

2. Click on the trash can icon next to the points of entry for firewalls, edge services, or sites you want to remove.

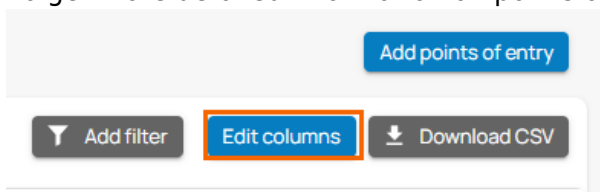

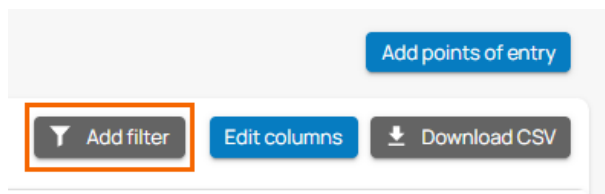
3. Select the field names you wish to display the columns for, and click **Save**.
