

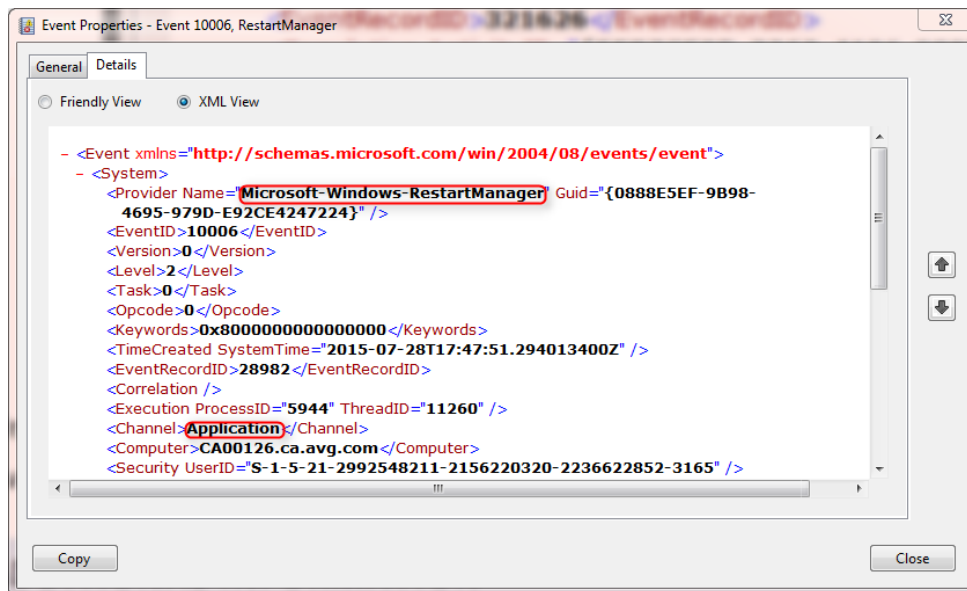
**Title:** How to collect and monitor non-standard or tiered windows event logs

**Description:** The process is very similar to monitoring standard Windows events, however specific details are needed to properly collect the event as the Source and Log name may differ from what it displayed in the Windows event viewer.

**Version:** All Managed Workplace version

### Body:

1. Find the Windows Event which needed to be monitored in Windows Event Viewer
2. Right click on the event and select 'Event Properties'
3. Select 'Details' tab
4. Select 'XML View'
5. Locate 'Provider Name' and 'Channel' and take a note of the values



6. Create a Windows Events monitor for this windows event
7. Select '(Specify Log)' for Event Log and select '(Specify Source)' under event source
8. Use 'Channel' value as the 'Log Name' and 'Provider name' as the 'Event Source'
9. Once this information has been properly added, save the monitor and if possible use event create or generate the event through other means to test the alert.
